Q: How do I access MCIS?

A: You can access MCIS from the MCIS website: <https://portal.mncis.intocareers.org/>

Q: What does MCIS offer for career planning?

A: MCIS offers several options for career planning. From the “Assessments” tab on the blue Mega menu, there are tools to help identify career interests and skills. Each assessments can be taken multiple times and will be saved to your account when you are logged in. From the “Occupations” tab on the blue Mega menu, you are able to research careers by name, field or by sorting based on factors that are important to you. You can also compare two different occupations and learn about the military.

Q: What does MCIS offer for college planning?

A: MCIS offers a wealth of tools to help students discover their options. From the “Education” tab on the blue Mega menu, students can search for colleges by name or by sorting based on factors that are important to them. Factors in the sort include degree type, school size, location, tuition costs and much more. Once options are narrowed as much or as little as desired, you can save the results to keep as a reference.

A good place to start is in Programs of Study. This will show which occupations are related to certain types of study areas (for example in Accounting someone could be an Accountant, Auditor, Tax Examiner). A step by step guide can help you make that decision by relating it to assessments in MCIS, as well as other factors

There is also a section for learning about how to pay for school, including a list of nearly 3,000 scholarships and links to learn about financial aid. Information on short-term training for students who may not be interested in a 2-year or 4-year college is available as well. All of this information can be saved to your portfolio for later review.

Q: What does MCIS offer for high school planning?

A: Students can use the course planner to keep track of which classes they are taking, how many credits they are and the grade they received. Some schools will load the courses offered into the site and they can be selected by using the drop down menu. If your school does not offer this, the tool can still be used by entering each course manually. The Course Planner can be found from the “Plan” tab on the blue Mega menu.

Q: Where do I find things that I have saved?

A: In the My Portfolio tab, you can find everything you’ve saved. Search results and assessments you’ve taken can be found by clicking on “Sort and Assessment Results” and colleges, programs of study, and occupations you’ve saved can be found by clicking on “Favorites.”

Q: What else can I find in MCIS?

A: There are several other things that can be done in MCIS. They include:

- A resume creator
- Job search information (how to search, job interviews, salary negotiations, employment laws)
- Information on Apprenticeships
- Some schools offer College entrance exam practice test
- Experiential learning
- Access to a Personal Learning Plan and PLP on the Go
- And much more!
