The **optional add-on packages** listed below are available with an annual MCIS license. Each allows unlimited usage. **NOTE:** licensing periods for these packages run from September 1 (any given year) to August 31 (following year).

\$ 385	Academic Practice Test Package includes the ACT, SAT, PSAT, ASVAB, GED; the College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) for English, Humanities, Mathematics, Natural Sciences and Social Studies; and TOEFL Writing, Vocabulary and Reading.
\$ 315	Civil Service Practice Test Package includes tests for the American Foreign Service Officer, Caseworker, Corrections Officer, Firefighter, Court Officer, Police Officer, Police Promotion, State Trooper, Probation Officer and Real Estate.
\$ 315	Advanced Placement (AP) and SAT Subject Practice Test Package
\$ 336	College Placement Skills Training (CPST) Package is an online course with three full-length practice tests that simulate the Accuplacer. The CPST can also be used for diagnostic assessment of academic skills in Career Technical Education programs or for college and career readiness.

MCIS Jr. is a version of MCIS designed specifically for junior high/middle school students. This version includes:

- Career Cluster Inventory – an interest survey based on the 16 Department of Education Career Clusters
- IDEAS – a standardized interest self-survey normed for this age group
- Occupation Information
- Electronic Portfolio
- Activities to help students with career planning
